DPS Course Catalog

Discovery Public School students must earn 22.5 credits to graduate. We offer courses in all core subjects as well as a few elective courses.

Middle School

Middle school students are required to take the following courses:

Mathematics

- ➤ Math 6-7
 - Students in 6th and 7th grade repeat this class twice. Both 6th and 7th grade standards are covered across the two year span.
- ➤ Algebra 8
 - o 8th grade standards are covered in this course

Science

- ➤ Life Science, Physical Science, Earth Science
 - Middle school science standards are taught on a three year rotation.

English

➤ Middle school students take English for three years. All middle school standards are covered.

Health/PE

- Physical Education
 - o Middle school students take physical education classes each year.
- ➤ Health
 - Middle school student take a health class every year

Social Studies

- ➤ MN History, US History, Global Studies
 - Middle School social studies requirements are taught on a three year rotation.

High School

Mathematics

- ➤ Integrated Math 1A and 1B/Integrated Math 2A and 2B
 - Integrated Math 1 and 2 combine algebra and geometry standards are are taught on a two year rotation, with 1A and 2A the first year and 1B and 2B the second year.
- ➤ Integrated Math 3A/Integrated Math 4A
 - o Juniors and seniors take Integrated Math 3 and Integrated Math 4 on a rotating basis.

English

> English is taught each year to all high school students.

Science

- ➤ Biology A/Biology B
 - Ninth and tenth grade students take Biology A/B on a two year rotation.
- Chemistry/Physics
 - Chemistry and Physics are taken by all juniors and seniors on a rotating basis.

- ➤ Environmental Science
 - Environmental Science is taken by all students at some point in their 4 years at DPS.

Social Studies

- ➤ US History/World History
 - o US and World history are taken by 9th and 10th grade students on a two year rotation.
- ➤ World Geography
 - All juniors are required to take World Geography
- ➤ Civics/Economics
 - All students take Civics and Economics in their senior year.

Health/PE

- ➤ Health 9
 - Health is a requirement for graduation and is taken in ninth grade.
- > Physical Education
 - Physical Education is offered in 9th and 10th grade.

Career Readiness/Freshman Seminar

- ➤ Career Readiness
 - All seniors are required to take a Career Readiness class to prepare them for life after high school.
 They explore careers and the paths required to achieve. They also complete community service and create the annual yearbook.
- > Freshman Seminar
 - All ninth grade students are required to take Freshman Seminar. In this class, students learn about social-emotional skills to prepare them for success in life, career exploration, community service, and they help create the annual yearbook.
