

DPS Lead Testing and Remediation Policy

Water Source Inventory and Sampling Plan

The Director will conduct or update the inventory of all taps used for cooking or drinking water and will set a sampling schedule. All taps identified in the inventory are tested within 5 years.

The Director will conduct or coordinate hiring a contractor to complete first draw tap sampling. Sampling will follow the practices in the updated 2024 Model Plan.

- The school district or charter school must make the water source unavailable until the hazard has been minimized.
- The school district or charter school must, within 30 days of receiving the test result, either remediate the presence of lead to below 5 ppb, verified by retest, or directly notify parents of the test result.

Sampling began in July, 2022. Monitoring will be completed in July, 2027.

Interpreting Results and Remediation

The Director will conduct any required remediation upon administration approval. Results and remediation actions will be kept for at least 15 years. Discovery Public School will maintain a record of results. Results and remediation actions will be kept at 126 8th Street NW, Faribault MN

For lead levels ≥ 5 ppb: remediation will take place according to professional recommendations, which may include filters on water supplies used for drinking or cooking. Access to water sources will be removed until remediation has occurred and the water source has been retested.

Communication

Contact person is Dan Weisser (Director) The School will make all test results available as required.

Discovery Public School will make the availability of the information known to parents in the following ways.

- Post testing plan, results, and remediation efforts on the school website. Update the website annually.
- Provide an annual notice to families that includes where to find the testing plan, results, and remediation efforts on the website (provide a direct link).
